and God bless you.

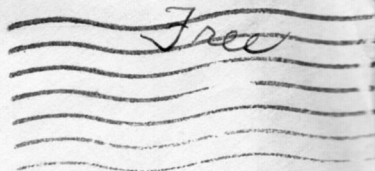
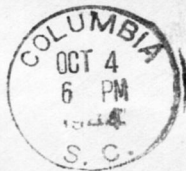
